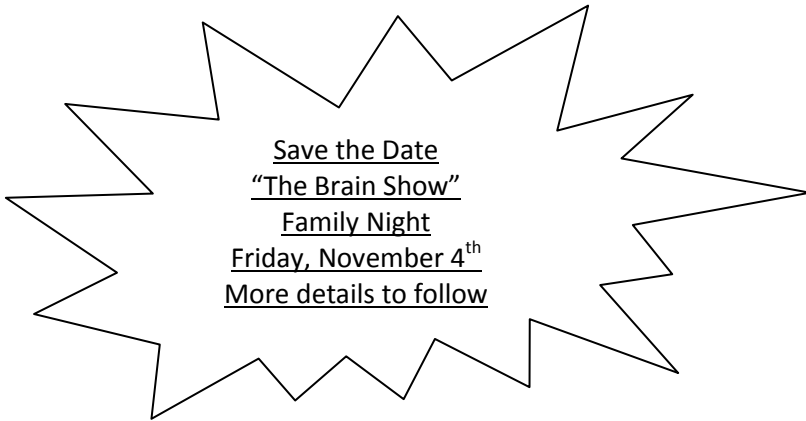


Halloween Parties
